Disturb other users' study and research activities

Bring food or drinks



Leave books and personal items unattended. They are under your responsibility

Occupy study spaces or seats without booking



Bring in bulky items (e.g. scooters and skateboards)

Remove your shoes, rest your feet on chairs and tables



Take photos and make videos without permission
